Nîmes Grande Provence Méditerranée:

5 mil (8km) from Nîmes city centre / 20 min by car

Montpellier Méditerranée:

27 mil (45 km) from Nîmes / 35 min by car

Marseille Provence :

68 mil (110 km) from Nîmes / 1h10 min by car

Paris Roissy- Charles de Gaulle:

2h50 min by train – TGV line (direct)

Toulouse Blagnac:

189 (305 km) from Nîmes / 2h50 min by car or train

Nice Côte d'Azur:

169 mil (273 km) 2h40 min by car










