# LONDON & SURROUNDS BY RAIL

## Day 1 - Arrival in London

Arrive in London and check into a central hotel. Spend the afternoon exploring Trafalgar Square and The National Gallery. In the evening, stroll around Covent Garden and perhaps catch a West End show. Overnight: London.

## Day 2 - Cambridge

Take an early train from London to Cambridge (1 hour). After checking into your hotel, explore the university's historic colleges and visit the Fitzwilliam Museum. ## Day 4 - Bath

ancient history. Explore Bath Abbey and walk through the Royal Crescent. Spend your evening relaxing at the modern Thermae Bath Spa. Overnight: Bath.

## Day 5 - Bath

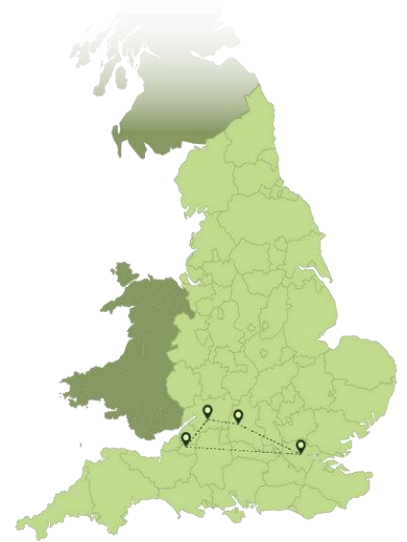

Enjoy another relaxing evening in Bath, perhaps with a scenic walk to see the Pulteney Bridge. Overnight: Bath.

## Day 6 - Return to London

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at your hotel and take a final morning stroll through London, perhaps picking up some last-minute souvenirs or enjoying a coffee at a nearby café. Check out of your hotel and head to the airport or train station for your departure, concluding your memorable journey
