SUMMER OF ARTS & INSPIRATION

5 Days / 4 Nights Itinerary

Day 1: Zurich – Arrival & Private Art Tour

Arrive in Zurich and settle into the Baur au Lac, a palace hotel overlooking Lake Zurich. Begin your cultural immersion with a private tour of the Kunsthaus Zurich, home to masterpieces from Swiss and European artists. Evening: exclusive dinner at Pavillon, a Michelin-starred restaurant offering creative gastronomy with lake views.

Day 2: Basel – Art Basel & Architecture

Travel first-class to Basel, a city where art and history converge. Enjoy VIP access to Art Basel (or private galleries if off-season) and a curated architectural tour including the works of Herzog & de Meuron. Lunch at Cheval Blanc by Peter Knogl, a three-Michelin-starred experience. Afternoon: stroll through medieval streets and riverside promenades.

Overnight at Grand Hotel Les Trois Rois, a historic palace with refined luxury.

Day 3: Bern – Heritage & Museum Privileges

Discover Bern's UNESCO World Heritage Old Town with a private guide. Visit the Einstein Museum, Bern Historical Museum, and hidden courtyards rarely seen by tourists. Afternoon tea at Alpenblick, overlooking the Aare River. Evening: gourmet dinner featuring Swiss contemporary cuisine. Overnight stay at Bellevue Palace, a landmark of elegance and service. the mountain.

Day 4: Lausanne – Art, Olympic Legacy & Vineyard Views

Travel to Lausanne, Switzerland's Olympic city. Private tour of the Olympic Museum

and a curated visit to local contemporary art galleries. Afternoon: chauffeured vineyard tour in Lavaux with private wine tasting. Evening: dinner at La Table d'Edgard, a Michelin-starred experience, followed by a lakeside stroll.

Day 5: Montreux – Jazz, Scenic Trains & Departure

End your summer cultural journey in Montreux, famed for its jazz festival. Enjoy a private scenic train ride along Lake Geneva's shoreline. Explore Chillon Castle with exclusive access and guided insights into its history. Farewell lunch on a terrace with panoramic lake views, followed by a private transfer to Geneva or Zurich airport.
