◆ ACCESS



By train, from Paris :

- From Roissy CDG airport to Bordeaux : 6 trains (TGV) a day, duration 2h50
- From Paris Montparnasse station to Bordeaux : 17 trains a day, duration 2h04

By train, inside the Nouvelle-Aquitaine region :

Easy travel between the region's major cities from Bordeaux!



- Bordeaux - Biarritz : 2h
- Bordeaux - Pau : 2h10
- Bordeaux - Sarlat : 2h20
- Bordeaux - Cognac : 2h10
- Bordeaux - Poitiers : 1h20



By plane :

- Direct flights from Roissy CDG airport to Bordeaux (1h15), Biarritz (1h30) and from all major European cities

- ✓ Over 30 million tourists visit Nouvelle-Aquitaine every year with 4 million foreign visitors


130 000 American visitors in 2019, 680 000 nights spent in the region



What's new ?


Bordeaux Wine Festival






