4 Days/3 Nights Itinerary

DAY 1 : BORDEAUX

Arrival at the airport. Welcome by your driver-guide and transfer to your hotel. On the road you'll enjoy a panoramic city tour of Bordeaux, a UNESCO World Heritage site. From vestiges of the Middle Ages to the elegance of the 18th century, you'll discover the golden ages of Bordeaux's history, dominated by the wine trade. Welcome dinner & overnight in Bordeaux. **(D)**

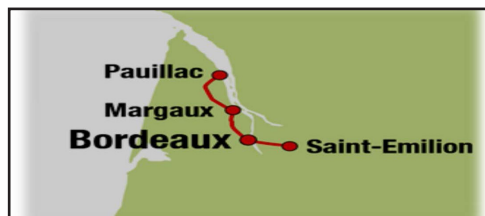
DAY 2 : FULL DAY TOUR MÉDOC

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, you'll depart for the Médoc, the most famous of the Bordeaux vineyard areas — located north-west of Bordeaux city, with a vast spit of land between the Atlantic Ocean to the west and the Gironde estuary to the east. Its geographical location allows a temperate climate ideally suited to wine-growing. This optimal symbiosis of viticulture and environment has created 60 Grand Crus Classés and 400 Crus Bourgeois in the AOC of the Médoc. Enjoy visiting and tastings in prestigious Château : Grand Cru Classé, Appellation Margaux, Appellation Pauillac, Appellation Pes-sac, Appellation Saint-Julien, Appellation Saint-Estephe. Back to Bordeaux and overnight at your hotel. **(B)**

DAY 3 : FULL DAY TOUR ST-ÉMILION

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, you'll depart for Saint Emilion. Enjoy a walking tour of the medieval city of Saint-Émilion, a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the centres of Bordeaux wine-making.

Saint-Émilion's other speciality is the macaron - unlike the brightly coloured filled macarons of today, these were created in 1620 by Ursuline nuns. The secret recipe was passed down through the centuries, and today Nadia Fermigier is the only custodian of the authentic recipe. You'll enjoy a visit at the Fermigier shop, followed by a macarontasting session. In the afternoon, enjoy a visit and wine tasting at Château Ferrand (Grand Cru Classé, Appellation Saint-Émilion). Following this, you'll visit the medieval city and UNESCO-World Heritage site of Saint-Émilion, one



of the main centres of Bordeaux wine-making. Back to Bordeaux, with dinner in a gourmet restaurant and overnight at the hotel. **(B, WT, D)**

DAY 4 : DEPARTURE

Breakfast at your hotel. Pick up at your hotel by a private coach and your guide and transfer to Bordeaux Airport or train station. **(B)**





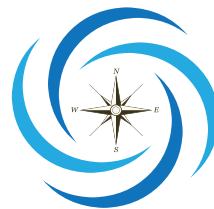
